7. Submissions will be selected for publishing by a panel within the City of Melton.
8. Selected submissions will be notified of vouchers before publishing.
9. The first ten submissions will be notified about voucher within a week of their submission.
10. Selected stories and full name will be published online by Melton City Council, by entering, you agree to have your work published. Please notify us upon submission if you do not want your full name published (first name only).
11. By submitting your stories, you are consenting to publishing your stories and full name online. Please tell us if you do not want your full name published
12. You may also be contacted by the mural artists for further consultation as part of the creative research process. Please tell us if you do not want to be contacted by the artist.
