Lancefield Circuit Reserve Minor Upgrade Community Feedback

Between the 31 October and 11 November 2022, Melton City Council shared a proposed landscape plan with local residents to upgrade Lancefield Circuit Reserve. Feedback was collected via an online survey and a flyer in the mail. Below is a summary of the feedback that we received. This feedback helps Council to understand what is important to the community and why, as well as identify any other opportunities for improvements. The feedback was reviewed and used to update the park design.


Project Scope

The project scope includes the provision of a play space, associated amenity and additional understorey planting and trees for shade.

Feedback summary

Community feedback indicated strong support for the inclusion of play equipment and additional shade tree planting in this reserve. There was concern noted by the community regarding the proximity of the high-activity play elements to the road. This has been addressed by relocating the proposed multiplay unit into the central grassed space and by increasing the buffer between the swing set and Romsey Terrace. Council also acknowledges the strong support for a BBQ within this space. This could not be supported within the existing budget but the request will be referred to future parks programs.

Requests for skate facilities, a dog off-lead area, and sporting amenities were not supported due to the proximity to local residents and the reserve size, which limits the opportunity to create appropriate safety buffers between these activities and the road.
