Splendour Circuit Reserve Minor Upgrade Community Feedback

Between the 31 October and 11 November 2022, Melton City Council shared a proposed landscape plan with local residents to upgrade Splendour Circuit Reserve. Feedback was collected via an online survey and a flyer in the mail. Below is a summary of the feedback that we received. This feedback helps Council to understand what is important to the community and why, as well as identify any other opportunities for improvements. The feedback has been reviewed and was used to update the park design.

Project Scope


The project scope includes the installation of additional play equipment, improvements to associated amenities and the inclusion of additional understorey planting and trees for shade.

Feedback summary


Community feedback indicated support for the inclusion of traditional play equipment, nature play, and picnic facilities. In particular, there was strong support for swings and play equipment that caters to younger age groups.

Council acknowledges the requests for support for a basketball court and sporting infrastructure within this space. This request could not be supported within the existing project budget but will be referred to future parks programs.

Requests for a dog off-lead area were not supported due to the reserve size and adjacent land uses. Public toilet requests are only supported at district and regional scale parks.
