

# Stretton Drive Reserve Minor Upgrade

## Community Feedback

Between the 17<sup>th</sup> October and the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 2022 Melton City Council shared with the local community of Stretton Drive Reserve, Brookfield a proposed landscape plan to upgrade the existing park.

Feedback was collected via an online survey, a hard copy flyer, and email. Below is a summary of the feedback that was collected.

This feedback helps Council to understand what is important to the community and why, as well as identify any other opportunities for improvements. The feedback is reviewed and will be used to update the park design.

### Project Scope

The project scope includes the installation of additional play equipment, improvements to associated amenities and the inclusion of additional understorey planting and trees for shade.

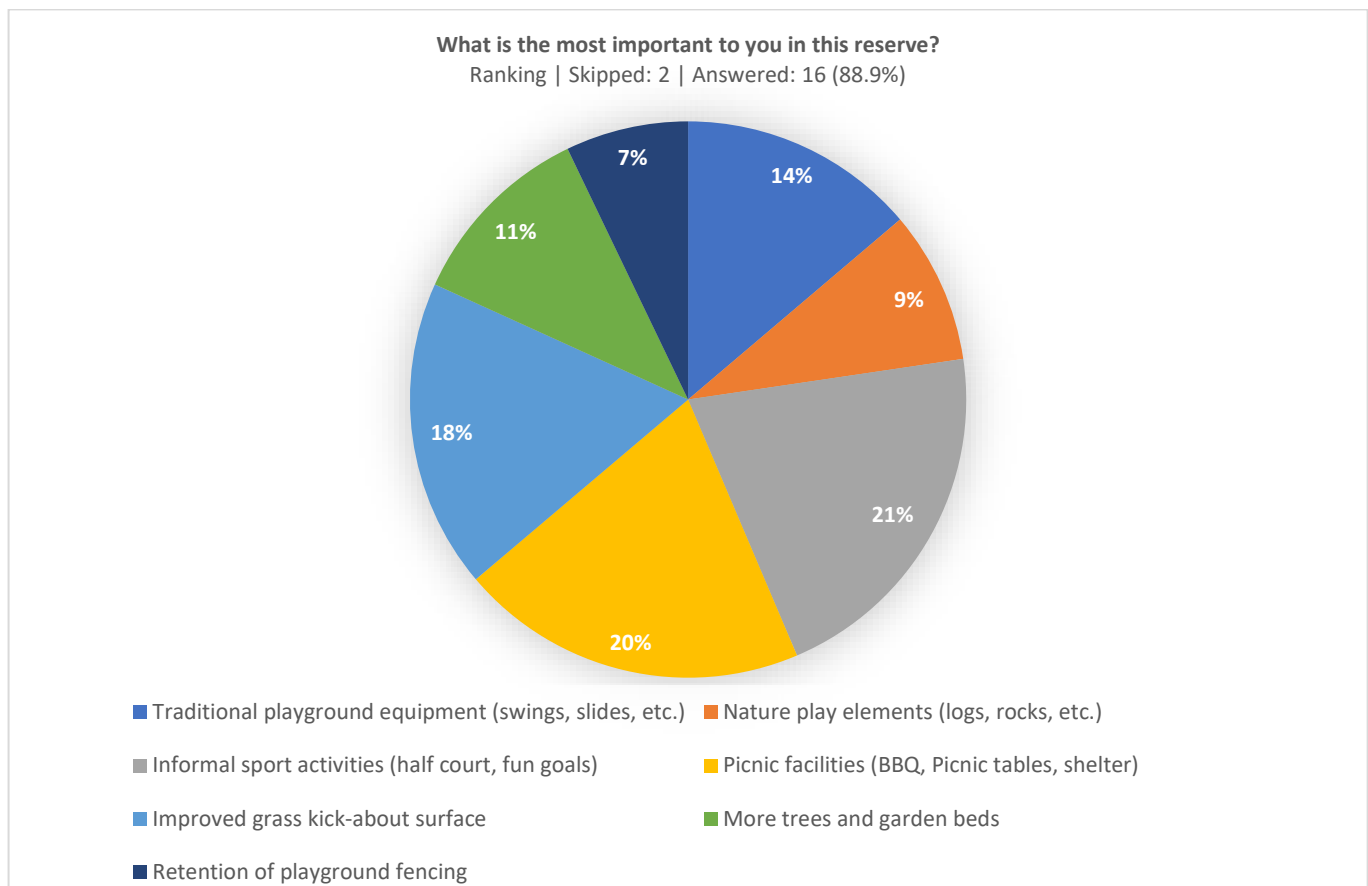
### Feedback summary

Community feedback indicated support for the inclusion of informal sport activities, improvement to picnic facilities, and improvement to the kick-about surface.

Council acknowledges that a half basketball court is not supported by the community within this space. This item was removed from the scope and replaced with a multi-use goal.

Requests for a dog off-lead area were not supported due to the reserve size and adjacent land uses. Public toilet requests are only supported at district and regional scale parks.
